# Public Notice

The Town of Arlington through its Parks and Recreation Commission is in the process of renovating and improving the Arlington Reservoir. The project includes but is not limited to bank stabilization, pathway improvements, landscape improvements, improved beach parking and access, various beach enhancements, a new playground, a picnic pavilion, renovated bathhouse & pump house facilities, improved site improvements and amenities, a new boat ramp, and a focus on improved accessibility for all.

The project has been awarded and preliminary renovations are underway. The project has received approval from both the Arlington and Lexington Conservation Commissions. The Town of Arlington has also received permission from the Town of Lexington to access some of the perimeter path work through Rindge Park in Lexington. Access will be limited in scope, schedule, and hours as detailed below.

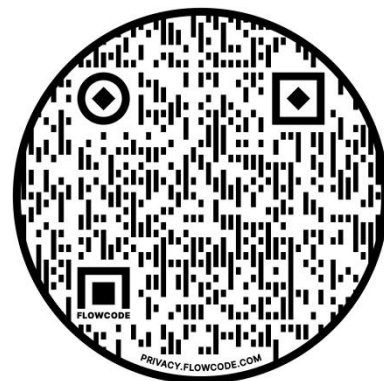
### PARK ACCESS INFORMATION AND DETAILS

Dates: May 17 – 7/2 (exact end date depends on weather, 8 weeks)

Times: Four 10 -hour work days per week -7:00 pm – 5:00 pm

Delivery of Material Times: 7:30 pm – 12 Noon

- All construction materials to be stored on Town of Arlington property
- Access point is through existing chain link fence double gate
- Ground protection mats will be used to protect turf areas
- A 6' high temporary chain link fence shall protect the driving route
