You are receiving this letter as an abutter of Rindge Park, located on Rindge Avenue. The 2021 Annual Town Meeting appropriated \$170,000 of Community Preservation Funds for the Recreation Committee's request for Parks and Playground Improvements at the Rindge Park. The project will update and replace the playground equipment and safety surfacing at the Rindge Park. As part of these park improvements, signage, park benches, trash receptacles and a bike rack will be updated or replaced, as well as the installation of fencing around the perimeter of the playground. Improved and additional ADA pathways will also be installed as part of this project.
