3	Added an enlargement for the Golden Ave buffer area	Layout
4	Added a black vinyl chain link fence and gate at the Golden Ave property line	Layout
5	Replaced all proposed sweetgum trees with shagbark hickory trees	Planting
6	Replaced all white spruce trees with various species already on the plant list	Planting
7	Included a note stating the contractor will remove all invasive species within the limit of work	Planting
8	Included a note indicating the intent to use dimmable or timed parking lot lights in areas not needed for staff parking at night.	Photometrics
9	Various stormwater management changes made in response to Woodard and Curran peer review	Site Preparation/Utility/Grading/Details
