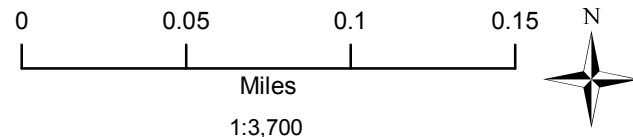

Poor Farm

11 acres, 0.6 miles of trail. Poor Farm was the former site of a farm that provided food for those who lived in the Town Poor House. The property features a grassy knoll edged by apple trees and a small forested area.

Access is from the junction of Hill Street and Cedar Street, and from further north on Cedar Street. Limited parking is available along Cedar Street.
