Subject: Amplifier and Speaker Use

It has come to our attention that there are groups and organizations using amplifiers and speaker's onsite at Lincoln Park, causing a disturbance to the abutters as well as those onsite enjoying the other amenities at the park.

The use of amplification should be requested on specific days of use when associated with a permit request, ie: game announcer, etc. Regular use of the amplified sound/music should discontinue.

The abutters in the neighboring areas of any fields and parks can be disturbed if music is being played too loudly.

If and when you receive approval to use an amplifier or speaker onsite associated with your field permit, the day of week and time will need to be considered to respect all park users and abutters.

Please make sure that those in your organization are aware of this and addressed.
