# Climate Action Plan – What is it?

Climate Action Plan (CAP) is an extensive and community driven process to lay out a roadmap for Lexington's Climate actions for the next five years.

# CAP – Why is it Important?

Create a roadmap to reach net zero by 2035.

Values and promotes broad mitigation strategies that also enhance community resilience and racial justice.

# CAP - Phases

There are 3 phases to this plan

- Phase I Stakeholder mapping, internal capacity building and baseline data collection
- Phase II Engagement launch and execution
- Phase III Plan development

# CAP – Phase II & III Add On

During Phase I Workshops additional engagement strategies were created including:

- GIS Storymap
- Business Sticker Campaign
- Information Residencies
- Youth Ambassador Program
- Final Report Showcase (interactive digital presentation)
