## Bridge Reconstruction Work on Route 2A (Marrett Road) Over I-95

*Preliminary work to begin on Tuesday, September 5*

**LEXINGTON-** The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is announcing preliminary construction activities for the Route 2A (Marrett Rd) Bridge Replacement Project over I-95 will begin on Tuesday, September 5. The preliminary work will consist of clearing roadside vegetation and other activities to allow for ramp re-alignment work necessary to accommodate bridge demolition over the winter months.

Traffic impacts are expected to be minimal and police details will be utilized for safety and coordination. Pedestrian access across the bridge will be maintained.

Appropriate signage, law enforcement details, and messaging will be in place to guide drivers through the work area.

Drivers who are traveling through these areas should expect delays, reduce speed, and use caution.

This work is weather permitting and subject to change.
